This person will develop direct connections with hundreds of entrepreneurs from across North Carolina and foster direct relationships with hundreds of Venture Capital firms that invest in these companies. He/she needs to become the "go-to" expert for both parties. More specifically, he/she will:

- Assess the capital requirements of these companies, and help coach or connect them to resources that can help them to be more investable
- Build strong working relationships with hundreds of Venture Capital firms, understand their key criteria for making investments
- Make curated "warm introductions" between companies seeking capital and investors seeking new companies
- Help track the funding across the state (see <u>Innovators report</u>)
- Keep track of company milestones via our robust dataset



- Track connections and be able to report key performance indicators
- Help increase awareness and usage of the service both in the community, with CED partners and with investors in other parts of the country.
