- Managing communication in regards to event registration & pitch applications
- Keeping event & membership databases up to date

In accordance with the Intern's interests and abilities, he/she will likely gain:

- Experience managing a Salesforce database
- Exposure to the NC entrepreneurial ecosystem, including tech and life science entrepreneurs, accelerators/incubators, investors, and industry thought leaders
- Insight into one of the Nation's leading entrepreneurial hubs
- Experience planning and executing multifaceted programs and events

Ideal candidates should have excellent attention to detail and strong organization and communication skills. Interns should also be self-motivated and quick learners who exhibit leadership and ability to work cohesively as a team player. An enthusiasm and desire to support and share the stories of the North Carolina entrepreneurial community is a must.

Requirements:

- Current enrollment at a college/university
- Based in the Triangle with reliable transportation to work at the CED office
- Letter from school stating that intern will receive college credit
- Proficiency using Microsoft Office programs
- Personal computer that can be used at work
- Availability to work at least 10-15 hours per week at CED
